		<b>Up to 8 screenshots</b> showcasing the functionality of the app. They should be in the JPEG or 24-bit PNG format and be from 320 px to 3840 px
		<b>512px by 512px icon</b> in the 32-bit PNG format that is not larger than 1024 KB
		Promo video is optional
		Tags helping users locate relevant apps
		<b>Localization</b> of your app, so users from different countries can benefit from it
		App's type (Games or Apps) and its category
		<b>Contact details</b> , so users can contact you on your website, via email, or phone.
